Wabash's Harbaugh, North Central's Spencer and Radtke Highlight 2005 *Football Gazette's* North All-Region Team

WESTMONT, Illinois -- North Coast Athletic Conference Offensive Player of the Year **Russ Harbaugh**, from Wabash, record-setting receiver, **Tyke Spencer** along with teammate and tackle wizard, **Lenny Radtke** from North Central College, headline a talented 2005 *Don Hansen's Football Gazette* NCAA Division III North All-Region team. North Central's **John Thorne**, was name North Region Coach of the Year after leading the Cardinals' to the NCAA Div. III playoffs for North Central's first-ever appearance, while finishing with an overall record of 9-2 for the season.

Harbaugh was proclaimed the Offensive Back of the Year, while Spencer claimed the Offensive Receiver of the Year Award and teammate, Radtke was declared the Linebacker of the Year. Senior **Mike Zeifert** from Augustana earned Offensive Lineman of the Year accolades, and teammate, **Tom Anthony** was designated the Defensive Back of the Year, while **Rob Tamillow** from the University of Chicago claimed the Defensive Lineman of the Year award. Ohio Northern's **Wesley Hostetler** received the Special Teams Player of the Year award.

Harbaugh, a senior, from Evansville, Indiana, is the 2005 North Coast Athletic Conference Offensive Player of the Year, he led Wabash to the NCAC title with a perfect 10-0 regular season record, a 7-0 mark in conference play, and a first round win over Albion in the Division III playoffs. Along the way he rewrote both the school and conference record books, becoming the first Little Giant quarterback to throw for over 3,000 yards in a season. His 3,521 passing yards set the Wabash and NCAC records. He also set both school and conference records for single game completion percentage (19-of-20 for 95 percent vs. Denison), season completion percentage (273-of-394 for 69.3 percent), and the single season completions total. He also owns the Wabash and NCAC completion percentage record, finishing his four-year career with a mark of 65.4 percent (568-of-869)..

Spencer, a senior, from Naperville, Illinois, was named to the CCIW First Team for the second year in a row after hauling in 59 catches for 1137 yards (19.3 avg. per catch, 113.7 avg. per game) for 15 touchdowns. He broke his own single-season mark for TDs caught while also becoming the leader in career receptions, yards gained receiving and TDs caught. Spencer a 2005 Gagliardi Trophy nominee and Lindy's National College Football Annual Preseason All-Division III Team along with a selection to the 2004 *Football Gazette* All-American Second Team Offense, holds every NCC receiving record. He missed almost all of the playoff game against Capital, due to an injury suffered early in the first quarter, and conceivably would have added to his totals as North Central lost a close game to Capital, 21-19.

Radtke, a senior, from Carol Stream, Illinois, is an American Football Coaches Association First Team pick for 2005. He was also a pre-season First Team pick by many publications. Radtke is a CCIW All-Conference First Team selection for the third straight year after leading his team in tackles with 152 (73 solo, 79 assisted), 12 tackles for a loss of 35 yards, two sacks for a loss of 15 yards, two interceptions returned for 25 yards, 13 pass breakups, two forced fumbles and two blocked kicks (both returned for touchdowns) and helped lead team to NCAA III Playoffs for first time in school history.

Zeifert, a senior, from Antioch, Illinois, a team captain and three year starter, was the lynchpin in the Augustana rushing attack that finished the 2005 season ranked second in NCAA Division III with an average of 346.3 yards per game. He is a three time first team all-conference performer in the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin. This summer he was a consensus pre-season All-America selection. He helped the Vikings compile a 10-2 record this season that included the school's 20th CCIW title and 15th NCAA Division

III national playoff appearance. Augustana was perfect in the CCIW, compiling a 7-0 record and defeated Lakeland 49-22 in the first round of the playoffs before falling at Mount Union to end the season. He was also selected to play in the Aztec Bowl.

Anthony, a Senior, from Bettendorf, Iowa, is the CCIW conference Defensive Player of the Year. He led NCAA Div. III in interceptions with 13. His totals for the year were, 42 tackles (33 solo), two tackles for loss (-5 yards), one forced fumble, eight pass breakups. With his 13 interceptions he had 169 return yards, including one for a touchdown.

Tamillow, a senior, from Oak Park, Illinois, was the University Athletic Association Defensive Player of the Year in 2005. A three-time All-UAA selection, he finished the season with 24 tackles-for-loss (-89 yards) and 12 sacks (-59 yards) -- both Chicago modern era season records. Tamillow was selected to play in the Aztec Bowl in Toluca, Mexico. In 2005 he totaled 59 tackles (44 solo stops), forced two fumbles, broke up two passes and blocked three extra point kicks.

Hostetler, a senior, from Strasburg, Ohio, a First Team Ohio Athletic Conference pick, returned 13 kickoffs for 409 yards (31.5 yards per return), including one for a score, and had 30 punt returns for 467 yards (15.6 yards per return), including two for touchdowns. On defense he totaled 63 tackles (47 solo hits), including 5.5 tackles for loss (-17 yards) with one sack for minus -12 yards. Hostetler also broke up eight passes and returned his five interceptions for a total of 36 yards. He is also a First Team Football Gazette Defensive Back in 2005. Hostetler was voted the MVP in Team USA's win over the Mexican All-Stars in the Aztec Bowl on Dec. 17, 2005.

John Thorne, led his team to the best mark in school history (9-1) and an at-large bid to the NCAA championships. It was the first postseason appearance for North Central since the 1947 team, which lost 21-0 to Southern Illinois University in the Corn Bowl. In four years as head coach at North Central, Thorne has made his presence felt by elevating the Cardinals to national prominence. North Central finished with a 6-4 record in 2002, 7-3 record in 2003 and 2004 and this year at 9-2 (29-12 overall 71%). It is the first time back-to-back, seven-win seasons were posted since 1946-47 and only the second time ever in the program's 106-year history. In 2004, the Cardinals broke a 24-year losing streak to Augustana College with a dominant 31-10 victory. North Central also went 6-0 at Benedetti-Wehrli Stadium and broke 18 records on the year. Prior to North Central, Thorne spent 22 seasons as head coach of Wheaton Warrenville South High School (Formerly Wheaton Central High School). While coaching at the high school level, Thorne compiled an impressive 181-64 career record and rolled up four state championships (1992, 1995, 1996, 1998) and two state runner-up finishes. He also captured six DuPage Valley Conference titles in his tenure and earned DuPage Area "Coach of the Year" honors five times.
