## UW-Whitewater's Stanley, Sakellaris, Schebler and Kleppe Highlight 2006 *Football Gazette's* West All-Region Team

**NORTH AURORA, Illinois** ~ Three-time first-team all-conference pick, **Max Sakellaris**, Max Sparger Scholar-Athlete winner, **Ryan Kleppe**, leading receiver, **Derek Stanley**, and team point leader, **Jeff Schebler**, all performers on a very gifted UW-Whitewater squad, headline a talented 2006 *Don Hansen's Football Gazette* NCAA Division III West All-Region team. Wisconsin-Whitewater's **Bob Berezowitz** was named West Region Coach of the Year after leading the Warhawks to the NCAA Div. III Championship game for a second consecutive year with an overall record of 14-1 for the season.

Sakellaris was confirmed the Offensive Lineman of the Year, Schebler assumed the Offensive Special Teams Player of the Year Award, Kleppe was named Defensive Lineman of the Year, while Stanley earned Receiver of the Year accolades. Senior, **Andy Collins**, from Occidental was awarded Offensive Back the Year honors, and, **Kirby Carr**, from Bethel University was designated the Linebacker of the Year, while brother, **Brandon Carr**, claimed the Defensive Back of the Year award.

**Sakellaris**, a senior, from Oak Park, Illinois, is a three-time, first-team, all-conference pick. He helped UW-Whitewater average 36.1 points per game. Average 225.5 yards of passing offense per game, 177.7 yards rushing per game and 403.2 total offensive yards per game. A menacing presence on the offensive line, he was one of the outstanding factors that allowed the Warhawks to accumulate a 42-8 record over the past four years, including going 28-2 the past two falls.

**Schebler**, a freshman, from Davenport, Iowa, was named to the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference First Team. He converted 18-of-21 field goal attempts (85.7 percent), and made good on 68-of-70 extra point kicks (97.1 percent) in helping UW-Whitewater reach the NCAA Division III title game for the second consecutive year.

**Kleppe**, a senior, from Mount Horeb, Wisconsin, a two-time, first-team all-conference performer, in 2006 notched 61 tackles, including 24 tackles for loss (-142 yards) with 14.5 sacks (-121 yards) in performing yeoman duties for the Warhawks this past season from his defensive tackle slot. He also had a forced fumble, recovered a fumble and broke up a pass.

**Stanley**, a senior, from Verona, Wisconsin, is first in UW-Whitewater career stats in touchdown receptions (33). This past season he caught 63 passes for 1,114 yards and 17 touchdowns and averaged 18.1 yards per catch. Stanley also rushed for 19 yards on four carries and returned five kickoffs for 90 yards. He was a unanimous First team all-conference selection.

**Collins**, a Senior, from Zillah, Washington, is the Southern *California intercollegiate Athletic* Conference Offensive Player of the Year for the third consecutive season. He directed a 20-point fourth-quarter comeback Nov. 11 versus Whittier, earned SCIAC Athlete of the Week honors Nov. 1 following a 28-27 win over Cal Lutheran, completing 21-of-31 passes for 236 yards and two touchdowns versus Cal Lutheran, while also rushing for 105 yards. Collins broke a 77-yard touchdown run Sept. 30 versus Claremont-Mudd-Scripps. Ranked 12<sup>th</sup> in total offense (273.1), and 14<sup>th</sup> in passing efficiency (153.7). In 2006 he completed 203-of-309 passes (65.7 completion percentage) for 2,416 yards and 27 touchdowns. He was intercepted 10 times. Collins also rushed for 325 yards on 89 carries (3.7 yards per carry) and scored four touchdowns.

**Kirby Carr**, a senior, from Fergus Falls, Minnesota, was named to the AFCA Div. III all-star team for the Aztec Bowl. He was a leader on the defense for the 14<sup>th</sup> ranked total defense and 5<sup>th</sup> ranked rushing defense in nation. Carr was a 2006 Gagliardi Trophy Finalist, a 2006 Draddy Award Semifinalist and was chosen the Most Valuable Player in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference in 2006. He helped Bethel upset St. John's in the final game of the regular season, to gain a tie for the conference title and the automatic NCAA Division III playoff bid. This past season he totaled 68 tackles, including 14.5 tackles for loss (-66 yards) with 5.5 sacks (-43

yards). Carr also caused two fumbles and recovered one, broke up seven passes, intercepted three for 143 yards, including two for touchdowns.

**Brandon Carr**, a senior, from Fergus Falls, Minnesota, was a first-team all-conference selection, including receiving the most votes at his position. Carr led the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference in interceptions, was second in pass breakups and was third on the team in tackles. He is a three-time MIAC Player of the Week. His totals for the 2006 season were, 59 tackles, including two for four yards in losses. Carr also broke up 15 passes and had seven interceptions for 151 yards, including one returned for a touchdown.

**Bob Berezowitz** led his footballers to their second consecutive appearance in the Stagg Bowl in 2006. . He just completed his twenty-second year as a collegiate head coach, all at UW-Whitewater, Berezowitz is 159-72-4, a winning percentage of .685. Berezowitz was selected 2006 WIAC Football Coach of the Year. He is ranked second in games won among Whitewater football coaches. Berezowitz was a standout quarterback during his days with the Warhawks. He still has two school records and is tied for first in two others. He guided the Warhawks to a second place finish in America in 1966 when Whitewater played Waynesburg, PA in the NAIA championship game. During his standout year of 1966, Berezowitz was selected Associated Press Small College All-American. Berezowitz continued his football career in the Central United States Football League (semi-professional football), being named the MVP of the league in 1968. Berezowitz was not only a star quarterback but he was selected as an all-American in baseball as a catcher while at Whitewater. He had opportunities to sign professional baseball contracts but decided to become a coach instead. During his tenure at Whitewater his teams have always been in title contention winning seven conference championships. UW-W football players have earned a total of 54 all-American honors (not including those from 2006) as well as numerous all-conference honors under Berezowitz's tenure. This was his final season as he has selected to retire. These past two seasons his teams have compiled a 28-2 record. I remember seeing Bob in his playing days at Whitewater, a dynamic quarterback he was, in fact I have been going up to see football games at Whitewater since the mid-50's. May your retirement be a joyful one, and you will be missed by most in the media, and of course by your players and staff. God bless you..
