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### Hill Trophy Finalist Race, Hill Trophy Winner Woodhead Headline 2006 *Football Gazette* All-Southwest Region Team

WINONA, Minn. — Harlon Hill Trophy finalist tailback Germaine Race of Pittsburg State University and Harlon Hill Trophy winning running back Danny Woodhead of Chadron State College headline a talented 2006 All-Southwest Region Team selected by *Don Hansen's Football Gazette*.

This marks the fifth year *Football Gazette* has selected NCAA Division II All-Region teams. The national publication, an authority on small college football, has selected NCAA Division II All-America teams since 1998.

The first-team and second-team All-Region selections advance to a national ballot from which the 2006 NCAA Division II *Football Gazette* All-America team will be named later this month.

Race, a senior from Warrensburg, Mo., shattered the NCAA all-division all-time scoring record and the NCAA-II career rushing mark during his final collegiate season. Race, who finished third in balloting for the Harlon Hill Trophy, rushed 310 times for 1,944 yards and 31 touchdowns, helping the Gorillas to a 10-2 season. He finished his career with 658 points and 6,985 rushing yards.

Woodhead, a junior from North Platte, Neb., captured the Harlon Hill Trophy as the National Player of the Year during a record-breaking season for the Eagles. Woodhead set the NCAA all-division all-time single-season rushing record, carrying the ball 344 times for 2,756 yards and 34 touchdowns. He also set the NCAA-II single-season scoring mark with 288 points. Woodhead helped Chadron to a 12-1 record and an NCAA-II national quarterfinalist finish.

National Runner-up Northwest Missouri State University led the way with 10 honorees, including eight first-team selections. RMAC champion Chadron State, the regional runner-up, also had nine selections on the All-Region teams.

A total of 96 players earned some form of *Football Gazette* All-Southwest Region honors. Players from 28 of the 36 football-playing schools in the Southwest Region earned All-Southwest Region accolades.
